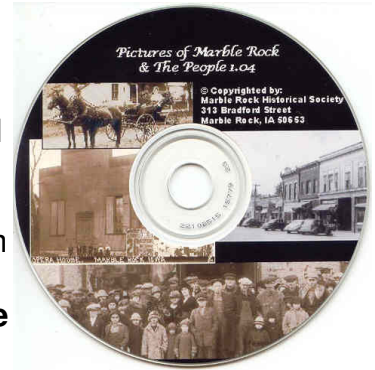


# Six Historical Computer CDs and DVD prepared by the Marble Rock Historical Society- 313 Bradford Street Marble Rock, IA 50653

## 1. Pictures of Marble Rock And The People CD

This CD for your computer contains nearly 3000 pictures and documents. Note: The JPEG files may be viewed with some DVD players and your television. Quality of pictures is often not as good as on your computer unless you have a high definition television screen.

See how the dam and power house were built. Check the beauty of the steel bridge built in 1875. Look at Main Street down through the years along with the disastrous fires that burned both sides. Many school pictures are provided including composite class pictures and an alphabetical listing of graduates. Trace family histories through photographs. Alphabetical listings of who is buried in the Hillside, Westside and St. Mary's Cemeteries may be researched. 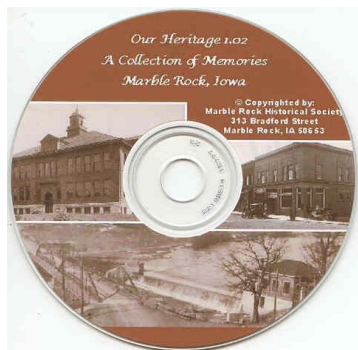

## 2. Our Heritage - A Collection of Memories CD

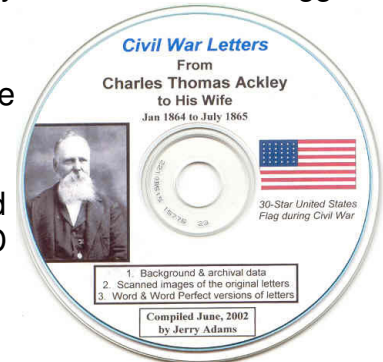


For the bicentennial in 1976, the Marble Rock Historical Society published a 136 page history of Marble Rock. Hundreds of printed copies were sold and the book is no longer available. Since requests are still being received, this history book may now be obtained on CD and viewed and printed from your computer with Acrobat Reader which is included on the disk. **Note:** This CD is now

searchable with your Adobe Reader. This allows you to find a name or event through a simple search procedure. **Price: Suggested Donation \$10.00 plus \$1.75 postage and packaging.**

### 3. Civil War Letters from Charles Thomas Ackley to his Wife CD

The 120 letters (200 pages) on this CD were written by C. T. Ackley to his wife who struggled at home with the farm and small children. They were written from January 1864 through July 1865 while serving at the battles of Atlanta, Dallas, Jonesboro and Sherman's March to the Sea. Of the 44,000 lowans that served in the Civil War, C. T. Ackley discusses Crumb, Asper, Sours, Clay, Jud, Parish and Hawks from Marble Rock. This CD contains photocopies of the hand written letters and Microsoft Word and Word Perfect translations for easy viewing. CD was compiled by Jerry Adams his Great Grandson. The originals are on file at the University of Iowa Library. **Suggested Donation \$10.00 plus \$1.75 postage and packaging.**



### 4. Marble Rock High School Annuals - 1948-1953 CD

In 1948, the Marble Rock High School Seniors published the first "Rocket" annual. This CD for your computer includes the first six annuals from 1948 through 1953. There are 335 pages that are setup to view or print with Acrobat Reader which is included in the disc. **Price: Suggested Donation \$10.00 plus \$1.75 postage and packaging.**

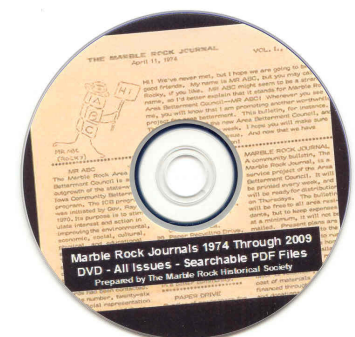


### 5. Marble Rock High School Annuals - 1954-1958 CD

Five annuals (249 pages) from 1954 through 1958 and Acrobat Reader for your computer are included on this disc.
